#### In the Name of Allah azwj the Beneficent, the Merciful

It was inform to us by Abu Muhammad Al Hassan Bin Muhammad Bin Yahya Al Fahham of Surmanrayy, from his uncle Umar Bin Yahya, from Ibrahim Bin Ubeydullah Al Kinany, from Abu Aasim,

From Al-Sadiq Ja'far<sup>asws</sup> having said: 'Our<sup>asws</sup> Shias are a part from us<sup>asws</sup>. They were Created from the remnants of our<sup>asws</sup> clay. It disappoints them what disappoints us<sup>asws</sup>, and it cheers them what cheers us<sup>asws</sup>. So, if anyone wants us<sup>asws</sup>, so let one strive for them (their nearness), for they are those who are the means for the one to (reach) us<sup>asws</sup>.'.

It was narrated to us by Ahmad Bin Abu Al Tayyib Bin Shuab, from Abu Al Fazal, from Ahmad Bin Hashim, from Malik Bin Suleyman, from his father, from Amro Bin Shimr, from Al Ahlaj, from Al Shai'e who said.

سُئِلَ الْحَسَنُ بْنُ عَلِيٍّ عِ عَنْ هَذِهِ الْآيَةِ اتَّقُوا اللَّهَ حَقَّ تُقاتِهِ وَ لا تَمُوتُنَّ إِلَّا وَ أَنْتُمْ مُسْلِمُونَ أَ خَاصَّةٌ هِيَ أَمْ عَامَّةٌ؟ قَالَ نَزَلَتْ فِي قَوْمِ خَاصَّةً فَتَعْقِيبِ عَامَّةٍ ثُمَّ جَاءَ التَّخْفِيفُ بَعْدَ فَاتَّقُوا اللَّهَ مَا اسْتَطَعْتُمْ

'Al-Hassan<sup>asws</sup> Bin Ali<sup>asws</sup> was asked about this Verse *[3:102] Fear Allah with the piety which is due to Him, and do not die unless you are Muslims*, is it special or general?' He<sup>asws</sup> said: 'It was Revealed regarding a particular group, and its commentary is general. Then came the lightening afterwards *[64:16] Therefore fear Allah as much as you can*'.

It was said, 'O son<sup>asws</sup> of Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup>! Regarding who was this Verse Revealed?' So he<sup>asws</sup> marked the ground for a while, then raised his<sup>asws</sup> sight, then lowered his<sup>asws</sup> head, then raised his<sup>asws</sup> head and he<sup>asws</sup> said: 'When this Verse was Revealed *[42:23] Say: I do not ask of you any Recompense for it except for the cordiality for my near relatives*, some of the people said, 'Allah<sup>azwj</sup> did not Reveal this, but rather he<sup>saww</sup> is intending to raise the arm of his<sup>saww</sup> cousin<sup>asws</sup>. They said it out of jealousy and hatred for the People<sup>asws</sup> of the Household of the Prophet<sup>saww</sup>.

So Allah<sup>azwj</sup> the Exalted Revealed [42:24] Or are they saying: He has forged a lie against Allah? But if Allah so Desired, He would seal your heart. You<sup>saww</sup> are not accustomed to these exchanges, nor let it be grievous upon you<sup>saww</sup> what they have been saying before and Allah will Wipe out the falsehood and confirm the Truth with His words; surely He is Aware of what is in the chests.

فَشَقَّ ذَلِكَ عَلَى رَسُولِ اللَّهِ ص وَ حَزَنَ عَلَى مَا قَالُوا وَ عَلِمَ أَنَّ الْقَوْمَ غَيْرُ تَارِكِينَ الْحَسَدَ وَ الْبَغْضَاءَ فَنَزَلَتُ هَذِهِ الْآيَةُ قَدْ نَعْلَمُ إِنَّهُ لَيَحْزُنُكَ الَّذِي يَقُولُونَ فَإِنَّهُمْ لا يُكَذِّبُونَكَ وَ لكِنَّ الظَّالِمِينَ بِآياتِ اللَّهِ يَجْحَدُونَ

It was grievous upon Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup> and he<sup>saww</sup> grieved upon what they said, and he<sup>saww</sup> knew that the people will not be leaving the envy and the hatred. So this Verse was Revealed [6:33] We know indeed that what they say certainly grieves you, but surely they cannnot call you a liar; but the unjust deny the Signs of Allah.

So when this Verse was Revealed *[5:67] O Rasool! Deliver what has been Revealed unto you from your Lord*, he<sup>saww</sup> said on the Day of Ghadeer Khumm: 'The one whose Master I<sup>saww</sup> was, so Ali<sup>asws</sup> is his Master. O Allah<sup>azwj</sup>! Befriend the one who befriends him<sup>asws</sup> and be Inimical to the one who is inimical to him<sup>asws</sup>'. So there occurred in their minds what occurred. They spoke in between them in secret to the extent that one of them said to his companion, 'The one will follow after the Prophet<sup>saww</sup>, and the one would follow after this matter, we will not let it (Caliphate) be in the People<sup>asws</sup> of the Household, ever!'

So it was Revealed [2:211] and whoever changes the Favour of Allah after it has come to him, then surely Allah is Severe in requiting (evil). Then it was Revealed [3:102] Fear Allah with the piety which is due to Him, and do not die unless you are Muslims [3:103] And hold fast by the Rope of Allah all together and be not disunited – up to His<sup>azwi</sup> Words [3:105] grievous Punishment.

So when the Prophet<sup>saww</sup> passed away, they went upon their opinion regarding the People<sup>asws</sup> of the Household of their Prophet<sup>saww</sup>, and what they had agreed upon during his<sup>saww</sup> lifetime, and threw behind their backs the Verses of Allah<sup>azwj</sup> Mighty and

Majestic, and the bequest of His<sup>azwj</sup> Rasool<sup>saww</sup> and the People<sup>asws</sup> of his<sup>saww</sup> Household, as if they were not knowing (anything)".2

Hadeeth: 'The one who dies upon the love of the Progeny<sup>asws</sup> of Muhammad<sup>saww</sup> dies a martyr', etc.

Relying upon the mentioned book, said, 'It was narrated to us by Ali Bin Ubeydullah, from Ismail Bin Abu Khalid, from Qays Bin Abu Hazim, from Jareyr Bin Abdullah Al Bajaly who said,

'Rasool-Allah saww said: 'The one dies upon the love of the Progeny of Muhammad<sup>asws</sup> dies a martyr. Indeed! And the one who dies upon the love of the Progeny<sup>asws</sup> of Muhammad<sup>saww</sup> dies (his sins having been) Forgiven for him. Indeed! And the one who dies upon the love of the Progeny<sup>asws</sup> of Muhammad<sup>asws</sup> dies a repentant. Indeed! And the one who dies upon the love of the Progeny asws of Muhammad dies a *Momin* of the complete *Eman*.

Indeed! And the one who dies upon the love of the Progeny<sup>asws</sup> of Muhammad<sup>saww</sup> is given the glad tidings of the Paradise by the Angel of death, the Munkar and Nakeer. Indeed! And the one who dies upon the love of the Progeny assws of Muhammad assww would be hastened to the Paradise just as the bride is hastened to the house of her husband. Indeed! And the one who dies upon the love of the Progeny<sup>asws</sup> of Muhammad<sup>saww</sup>, Allah<sup>azwj</sup> would Open two doors of the Paradise for him.

Indeed! And the one who dies upon the love of the Progenyasws of Muhammadsaww, Allahazwi would Make the Angels of Mercy to visit his grave. Indeed! And the one who dies upon the love of the Progeny<sup>asws</sup> of Muhammad<sup>saww</sup>, dies upon the Sunnah and the congregation.

Indeed! And the one who dies upon the hatred of the Progenyasws of Muhammadsaww would come on the Day of Judgment with an inscription between his eyes, 'Despaired from the Mercy of Allahazwi the Exalted'. Indeed! And the one who dies upon the enmity of Progeny<sup>asws</sup> of Muhammad<sup>saww</sup> dies a disbeliever. Indeed! And the one who dies upon the hatred of the Progeny asws of Muhammad would not smell the aroma of the Paradise".3

He said, 'It was narrated to us by Muhammad Bin Isa Bin Haroun, from Abu Abdul Samad Ibrahim, from his father, from his grandfather Muhammad Bin Ibrahim who said,

'I heard Al-Sadiq Ja'farasws Bin Muhammadasws saying regarding the Words of the Exalted [2:208] O you who believe! Enter into the submission one and all, he said: Into the Wilayah of Aliasws Bin Abu Talibasws and do not follow the footsteps of the Satan, he asws said: 'Do not follow other than him sws". 4

(By) the chain, from Ibn Haroun, said, 'It was narrated to me by Abu Abdul Samad Ibrahim, from his father, from his grandfather, and he is Ibrahim Bin Abdul Samad Bin Muhammad Bin Ibrahim who said,

'I heard Ja'far Bin Muhammadasws saying: 'It was being recited [3:33] Surely Allah chose Adam and Noah and the Progeny of Ibrahim and the Progeny of Imran and the Progeny of Muhammad above the nations – This is how it was Revealed'.5

The Ahadeeth of the Prophet<sup>saww</sup> with what would be occuring upon (Syeda) Fatima asws and upon Al-Hasaneyn asws

He said, 'It was narrated to us by Muhammad Bin Abu Abdullah Al Kufy, from Musa Bin Imran Al Nakhai'e, from his uncle Al Husayn Bin Yazeed Al Nowfaly, from Al Husayn Bin Ali Bin Abu Hamza, from his father, from Saeed Bin Jubeyr, from Ibn Abbas who said,

'Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup> was seated one day when Al-Hassan<sup>asws</sup> came over. So when he<sup>saww</sup> saw him<sup>asws</sup>, he<sup>saww</sup> wept, then said: '(Come) to me, (come) to me<sup>saww</sup>, my<sup>saww</sup> son<sup>asws</sup>!' and he<sup>saww</sup> did not cease to bring him<sup>asws</sup> closer until he<sup>saww</sup> sat him<sup>asws</sup> upon his<sup>saww</sup> right thigh.

Then Al-Husayn<sup>asws</sup> came over. So when he<sup>saww</sup> saw him<sup>asws</sup>, he<sup>saww</sup> wept (and) said: '(Come) to me<sup>saww</sup>! (Come) to me<sup>saww</sup>, O my<sup>saww</sup> son<sup>asws</sup>!, and seated him<sup>asws</sup> upon his<sup>saww</sup> left thigh.

Then (Syeda) Fatima<sup>asws</sup> came over. So when he<sup>saww</sup> saw her<sup>asws</sup>, he<sup>saww</sup> wept, then said: '(Come) to me<sup>saww</sup>! (Come) to me<sup>saww</sup>, O my<sup>saww</sup> daughter<sup>asws</sup>!, and sat her<sup>asws</sup> in front of him<sup>saww</sup>.

Then Amir Al-Momineen<sup>asws</sup> came over. So when he<sup>saww</sup> saw him<sup>asws</sup>, he<sup>saww</sup> wept, then said, '(Come) to me<sup>saww</sup>! (Come) to me<sup>saww</sup>, O my<sup>saww</sup> brother<sup>asws</sup>!, and he<sup>saww</sup> did not cease to bring him<sup>asws</sup> closer until he<sup>saww</sup> sat him<sup>asws</sup> by his<sup>saww</sup> right side.

So his<sup>saww</sup> companions said to him<sup>saww</sup>, 'O Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup>! You<sup>saww</sup> did not see any one of them<sup>asws</sup> except you<sup>saww</sup> wept, or isn't there in them<sup>asws</sup> what would cheer you<sup>saww</sup> by seeing it?' He<sup>saww</sup> said: 'By the One<sup>azwj</sup> Who Sent me<sup>saww</sup> with the Prophet-hood, and Chose me<sup>saww</sup> over the entirety of the Created beings, I<sup>saww</sup> and them<sup>asws</sup> are the most prestigious of the creatures to Allah<sup>azwj</sup> Mighty and Majestic, and there isn't a person upon the surface of the earth who is more beloved to me<sup>saww</sup> than them<sup>asws</sup>.

As for Ali<sup>asws</sup> Bin Abu Talib<sup>asws</sup>, so he<sup>asws</sup> is my<sup>saww</sup> brother, and my<sup>saww</sup> compassion and the Master of the Command after me<sup>saww</sup>, and the bearer of my<sup>saww</sup> flag in the world and

the Hereafter, and custodian of my<sup>saww</sup> Fountain, and my<sup>saww</sup> intercession, and he<sup>asws</sup> is the Master of every Muslim and Imam<sup>asws</sup> of every *Momin*, and guide of every pious one, and he<sup>asws</sup> is my<sup>saww</sup> successor, and my<sup>saww</sup> Caliph upon my<sup>saww</sup> family members, and my<sup>saww</sup> community, during my<sup>saww</sup> lifetime and after my<sup>saww</sup> passing away.

The one who loves him<sup>asws</sup> loves me<sup>saww</sup>, and his<sup>asws</sup> hater is my<sup>saww</sup> hater, and by his<sup>asws</sup> Wilayah my<sup>saww</sup> community would receive Mercy, and by his<sup>asws</sup> enmity the adversary of his<sup>asws</sup> came to be Accursed, and I<sup>asws</sup> wept when he<sup>asws</sup> came over because I<sup>saww</sup> remembered the treachery of the community with him<sup>asws</sup> after me<sup>saww</sup> to the extent that he<sup>asws</sup> would be moved from my<sup>saww</sup> seat although Allah<sup>azwj</sup> has Made it to be for him<sup>asws</sup> after me<sup>as</sup>. Then the matter would not cease to be such with him<sup>asws</sup> until he<sup>asws</sup> would be struck upon his<sup>asws</sup> forehead from which his<sup>asws</sup> beard would be dyed during the most superior of the months, [2:185] The Month of Ramazan is that in which the Quran was Revealed, a Guidance for the people and clear Proofs from the Guidance and the Criterion.

And as for my<sup>saww</sup> daughter<sup>asws</sup>, so she<sup>asws</sup> is the chieftess of the women of the worlds, from the former ones and the latter ones, and she<sup>asws</sup> is a part from me<sup>saww</sup>, and she<sup>asws</sup> is the light of my<sup>saww</sup> eyes, and she<sup>asws</sup> is the fruit of my<sup>saww</sup> heart, and she<sup>asws</sup> is my<sup>saww</sup> soul which is between my<sup>saww</sup> two sides, and she<sup>asws</sup> is "الْحُوْرَاءُ الْإِنْسِيَّةُ" the human Hourie.

Whenever she<sup>asws</sup> stands in her Prayer Niche in front of her<sup>asws</sup> Lord<sup>azwj</sup>, Majestic is His<sup>azwj</sup> Majesty, her<sup>asws</sup> light blossoms to the Angels of the sky just as the light of the stars blossom for the inhabitants of the earth, and Allah<sup>azwj</sup> Mighty and Majestic Says to His<sup>azwj</sup> Angels: "O My<sup>azwj</sup> Angels! Look at My<sup>azwj</sup> maid Fatima<sup>asws</sup>, chieftess of the women, standing in front of Me<sup>azwj</sup>, trembling during her<sup>asws</sup> Obligation from fearing Me<sup>azwj</sup>, and she<sup>asws</sup> has faced upon My<sup>azwj</sup> worship. I<sup>azwj</sup> have already Secured her<sup>asws</sup> Shias from the Fire".

And I<sup>saww</sup>, when I<sup>saww</sup> saw her<sup>asws</sup>, I<sup>saww</sup> remembered what would be done against her<sup>asws</sup> after me<sup>saww</sup>. It is as if I<sup>saww</sup> am with her<sup>asws</sup> and the disgraced one has entered her<sup>asws</sup> house and violated her<sup>asws</sup> sanctity, and usurped her<sup>asws</sup> rights, and prevented her<sup>asws</sup>

inheritance, and martyred her<sup>asws</sup> child, and she<sup>asws</sup> is calling out: 'O Muhammad<sup>saww</sup>!' and she<sup>asws</sup> is not being answered, and she<sup>asws</sup> is seeking help but she<sup>asws</sup> is not being helped.

She<sup>asws</sup> would remember the interruption of the Revelation from her<sup>asws</sup> house at times, and she<sup>asws</sup> would remember my<sup>saww</sup> separation at other times, and she<sup>asws</sup> would feel lonely when the night falls due to missing my<sup>saww</sup> voice which she<sup>asws</sup> used to hear from me<sup>saww</sup> when she<sup>asws</sup> holds a vigil with the Quran. Then she<sup>asws</sup> would see herself<sup>asws</sup> as being humiliated and in the days of her<sup>asws</sup> father<sup>saww</sup> she<sup>asws</sup> used to be honoured.

O Fatima<sup>asws</sup>! *[3:43] Be obedient to your Lord and bow down with those who bow*.

Then the pain would begin with her<sup>asws</sup> and she<sup>asws</sup> would fall ill, and Allah<sup>azwj</sup> Mighty and Majestic would Send Maryam<sup>as</sup> Bint Imran<sup>as</sup> to her<sup>asws</sup> during her<sup>asws</sup> illness and comfort her<sup>asws</sup> during her illness. So she<sup>asws</sup> would be saying during that: 'O Lord<sup>azwj</sup>! I<sup>asws</sup> tired of the life and fed up with the people of the world, therefore join me<sup>asws</sup> with my<sup>saww</sup> father<sup>asws</sup>!' So Allah<sup>azwj</sup> Mighty and Majestic would join her<sup>asws</sup> with me<sup>saww</sup>, and she<sup>asws</sup> would happen to be the first one to meet me<sup>saww</sup> from the People<sup>asws</sup> of my<sup>saww</sup> Household.

Curse the one who oppressed her<sup>asws</sup> and disgrace the one who humiliated her<sup>asws</sup>, and Make him to abide eternally in Your<sup>azwj</sup> Fire, the one who struck her<sup>asws</sup> side to the extent that her<sup>asws</sup> child was martyred!' So the Angels would be saying during that: 'Ameen!'

And as for Al-Hassan<sup>asws</sup>, so he<sup>asws</sup> is my<sup>saww</sup> son and my<sup>saww</sup> child, and is from me<sup>saww</sup>, and delight of my<sup>saww</sup> eyes, and the illumination of my<sup>saww</sup> heart, and fruit of my<sup>saww</sup> heart, and he<sup>asws</sup> is the chief of the youths of the inhabitants of the Paradise, and a Divine Authority of Allah<sup>azwj</sup> upon the community. His<sup>asws</sup> orders are my<sup>saww</sup> orders and his<sup>asws</sup> words are my<sup>saww</sup> words. The one who obeys him<sup>asws</sup> so he is from me<sup>saww</sup>, and the one who disobeys him<sup>asws</sup>, so he isn't from me<sup>saww</sup>.

And I<sup>saww</sup>, when I<sup>saww</sup> looked at him<sup>asws</sup>, I<sup>saww</sup> remembered what would be occurring upon him from the humiliation after me<sup>saww</sup>. His<sup>asws</sup> matter would not cease to be such with him<sup>asws</sup> until he<sup>asws</sup> is murdered with the poison unjustly, aggressively. So, during that the Angels and the seven skies would cry due to the difficulty of his<sup>asws</sup> death, and there would cry for him everything, to the extent of the birds in the atmosphere of the sky, and the fishes in the middle of the water.

So the one who cries for him<sup>asws</sup>, his eye would not be blinded on the Day in which the eyes would be blinded, and the one who grieves upon him<sup>asws</sup>, his heart would not be grieving on the Day the hearts would grieve, and the one who visits him<sup>asws</sup> in his<sup>asws</sup> spot (grave), his feet would be affirmed upon the Bridge on the Day the feet would be wavering.

And as for Al-Husayn<sup>asws</sup>, so he<sup>asws</sup> is from me<sup>saww</sup>, and he<sup>asws</sup> is my<sup>saww</sup> son<sup>asws</sup>, and my child, and the best of the creatures after his<sup>asws</sup> father and his<sup>asws</sup> brother<sup>asws</sup>, and he<sup>asws</sup> is the Imam<sup>asws</sup> of the Muslims, and Master of the Momineen, and the Caliph of the Lord<sup>azwj</sup> of the worlds, and the helper of the help-seekers, and a shelter of the shelter-seekers, a Divine Authority of Allah<sup>azwj</sup> upon His<sup>azwj</sup> creatures in their entirety, and this is the chief of the youths of the inhabitants of the Paradise, and the door of salvation of the community. His<sup>asws</sup> orders are my<sup>saww</sup> orders, and being obedient to him<sup>asws</sup> is being obedient to me<sup>saww</sup>. The one who obeys him<sup>asws</sup>, so he is from me<sup>saww</sup>, and the one who disobeys him<sup>asws</sup>, so he isn't from me<sup>saww</sup>.

And I<sup>saww</sup>, when I<sup>saww</sup> saw him<sup>asws</sup>, I<sup>saww</sup> remembered what would be done with him<sup>asws</sup>. It is as if I<sup>saww</sup> am with him<sup>asws</sup> and he<sup>asws</sup> is seeking shelter in my<sup>saww</sup> sanctuary and my<sup>saww</sup> grave, but he<sup>asws</sup> is not given shelter. So, I<sup>saww</sup> hug him<sup>asws</sup> to my<sup>saww</sup> chest during

my<sup>saww</sup> dream, and I<sup>saww</sup> instruct him<sup>asws</sup> with the departure from the house of my<sup>saww</sup> chamber and give him<sup>asws</sup> the glad tidings of the martyrdom.

So he<sup>asws</sup> departs from it to the land of his<sup>asws</sup> killing, and the place of his<sup>asws</sup> demise. A land of distress and affliction (*Karb wa Bala* – Karbala), and gossip, and ruination. A group from the Muslims would help him<sup>asws</sup>, they would be the chiefs of the martyrs of my<sup>saww</sup> community on the Day of Judgment.

It is as if I<sup>saww</sup> am looking at him<sup>asws</sup>, and he<sup>asws</sup> has been hit by an arrow, and he<sup>saww</sup> has fallen quickly. Then he<sup>asws</sup> is slaughtered just as the ram is slaughtered, oppressed'.

Then Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup> wept, and the ones around him<sup>saww</sup> wept and their voices were raised with the commotion. Then he<sup>saww</sup> said: 'O Allah<sup>azwj</sup>! I<sup>saww</sup> complain to You<sup>azwj</sup> of what the People<sup>asws</sup> of my<sup>saww</sup> Household would be facing after me<sup>saww</sup>!' And he<sup>saww</sup> entered his<sup>saww</sup> house'.<sup>6</sup>

From Abu Abdullah<sup>asws</sup> having said: 'Allah<sup>azwj</sup> did not Send a Prophet<sup>as</sup> at all from the Masters of the Command, from the ones who were Commanded with the fighting, except Allah<sup>azwj</sup> Strengthened him<sup>as</sup> until the people entered into his<sup>as</sup> Religion willingly as well as unwillingly. So when the Prophet<sup>as</sup> died, those who had entered into his<sup>as</sup> Religion unwillingly leapt (attacked) upon those who had entered it willingly, and they killed them and humiliated them to the extent that when the following (new) Prophet<sup>as</sup>

Anas said, 'A man from the Helpers (Ansaar) stood up to him<sup>saww</sup> and he said, 'O Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup>! So who would be hating Ali<sup>asws</sup> after this?' He<sup>saww</sup> said: 'O brother (from the) Ansaar! None from the Qureysh would hate him<sup>asws</sup> except for a foolish one, nor from the Helpers except for a Jew, nor from the Arabs except for a bastard, nor from the rest of the people except for a wretch".<sup>14</sup>

He said, 'It was narrated to us by Umar Bin Hisham, from Muslim, from Khaysama who said,

'I heard Sa'ad saying, 'The son<sup>asws</sup> of Abu Talib<sup>as</sup> has been given three characteristics. Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup> stood on the Day of Ghadeer Khumm in the middle of the day, then said: 'Are you knowing that I<sup>saww</sup> am closer with the Momineen than their own selves?' They said, 'Yes'. He<sup>saww</sup> said: 'The one whose Master I<sup>saww</sup> was, so Ali<sup>asws</sup> is his Master'.

And he<sup>saww</sup> said on the Day of Khyber: 'I<sup>saww</sup> shall give the flag to the most superior of you all, who isn't with the fleeing'. Then, in the morning, we were kneeling to his<sup>saww</sup> knees (in anticipation of receiving the flag), but, he<sup>saww</sup> called Ali<sup>asws</sup>, and it was said,

'There is pain in his asws eyes'. So they came with him asws and he saww supplicated that there should be victory of Khyber upon his asws hands on that day.

Then his<sup>asws</sup> house being in the Masjid of Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup>, and he<sup>saww</sup> said: 'I<sup>saww</sup> did not settle him<sup>asws</sup> (therein), it was Allah<sup>azwj</sup> Who Settled him<sup>asws</sup>".<sup>15</sup>

When the Muslims embarked upon the military expedition to the city of Rome, they found in their churches a couplet from the poems, 'Are they (still) hoping, the community which killed Husayn asws?'

'We went on a military expedition of Rome and we found in a church from their churches, inscribed: 'Are you hoping, O group who killed Husayn<sup>asws</sup>, for the intercession of his<sup>asws</sup> grandfather<sup>saww</sup> on the Day of Reckoning?'.

We said to the Romans, 'When was this inscribed in your church?' They said, 'Before the Prophet-hood of your Prophet saww by three hundred years". 16

From Ibn Masoud who said, 'Rasool-Allah saww said to me: 'When there was an Ascension with me<sup>saww</sup> to the sky, an Angel came to me<sup>saww</sup> and said to me: 'O Muhammad<sup>saww</sup>! Ask the ones who were Sent (as Prophets<sup>as</sup>) before you<sup>saww</sup>. I<sup>saww</sup> said: 'O group of the people and the Prophetsas! Upon what (stipulation) did Allahazwi Send you all before me<sup>saww</sup>?' They said, 'Upon (the stipulation) of your<sup>saww</sup> Wilayah, O Muhammad<sup>saww</sup>, and the Wilayah of Ali<sup>asws</sup> Bin Abu Talib<sup>asws</sup>". <sup>17</sup>

You are at the position which Allah<sup>azwj</sup> has Positioned you<sup>asws</sup> with, and your<sup>asws</sup> father<sup>as</sup> would be Punished by the Fire?'

If my<sup>asws</sup> father<sup>asws</sup> was to intercede regarding every sinner upon the face of the earth, Allah<sup>azwj</sup> the Exalted would Accept his<sup>asws</sup> intercession regarding them. Would my<sup>asws</sup> father<sup>as</sup> be Punished by the Fire and his<sup>asws</sup> son<sup>asws</sup> is the distributor of the Fire?'

'Ali<sup>asws</sup> gathered his<sup>asws</sup> (male) family members and they were eleven – Al-Hassan<sup>asws</sup> Bin Ali<sup>asws</sup>, and Al-Husayn<sup>asws</sup> Bin Ali<sup>asws</sup>, and Muhammad son of Ali<sup>asws</sup> the elder, and Umar son of Ali<sup>asws</sup>, and Muhammad son of Ali<sup>asws</sup> the younger, and Al-Abbas Bin Ali<sup>asws</sup>, and Abdullah son of Ali<sup>asws</sup>, and Ja'far son of Ali<sup>asws</sup>, and Usman son of Ali<sup>asws</sup>, and Abdullah son of Aliasws, and Abu Bakr son of Aliasws.

So when they had gathered in his asws presence, he asws said: 'O my sons, elder and younger! Do not become like the deceivers and the deserters, those who are not pondering in the Religion and have not been Given the certainty from Allahazwi like the whiteness of an egg inside which is the yellowness of the chick (Its state being uncertain). The Progeny<sup>asws</sup> of Muhammad<sup>saww</sup> are from the Caliphs made as Caliphs. The audacious devil would kill my replacement, and the replacement of the replacement (i.e., Imam<sup>asws</sup> after the Imam<sup>asws</sup>).

Then he asws said: 'By Allah azwi! I asws have taught the delivery of the Messages, and complete words, and the ratification of the Ahadeeth, and Iasws am wishing upon you all Hisazwi Bounties, People of the Household".20

Ibn Abbas, after his sight had been veiled (lost), passed by a group of Quryesh and they were reviling Ali<sup>asws</sup>. So he said to his guide, 'Return me to them'. So he returned him, and Ibn Abbas paused and said to them: 'Who was the one insulting Allah<sup>azwj</sup>?' They said, 'Glory be to Allah<sup>azwj</sup>, O Ibn Abbas! The one who reviles Allah<sup>azwj</sup> has associated'. And he said, 'And the one who reviles Muhammad<sup>saww</sup> so he has disbelieved'. So he said, 'Who was the one who reviled Ali<sup>asws</sup>?' They said, 'As for this, so it has happened'.

Ibn Abbas said, 'I testify to Allah<sup>azwj</sup> that I heard Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup> saying: 'The one who reviles Ali<sup>asws</sup> so he has reviled me<sup>saww</sup>, and the one who reviles me<sup>saww</sup> so he has reviled Allah<sup>azwj</sup>. Then he turned and went away, and he said to his guide, 'What did you hear them saying?' He said, 'They were not saying anything'. He said, 'How did you see their faces to be?'

He said (in prose), 'They looked at you with reddened eyes, the look of the goats to the butcher's knife.

Ibn Abbas said, 'Increase for me, may my father and my mother be sacrificed for you'.

So he said (in prose), 'Frowning of the eyebrows, disgraced of their necks, the look of the one humiliated to the compelling creditor'.

He said, 'Increase for me, may my father and my mother be sacrificed for you'.

So he said (in prose), 'Their lives are more shameful over their deaths, and they are dying upon an ancient scandal".<sup>21</sup>

He said, 'I have witnessed four for him<sup>asws</sup>, even if one of these would happen to be for me, it would be more beloved to me than the world and the life-span in it of the life-span of Noah<sup>as</sup>.

Has anything been Revealed regarding me<sup>asws</sup>?' He<sup>saww</sup> said: 'No, except for good, except that none should deliver it except I<sup>saww</sup> and a man from me<sup>saww</sup>' – or said: 'From my<sup>saww</sup> family'.

And when it was morning, Al-Abbas Came over to Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup> and he said, 'O Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup>! You<sup>saww</sup> have exited your<sup>saww</sup> uncles and your<sup>asws</sup> companions, and you<sup>asws</sup> have settled this boy?' Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup> said: 'I<sup>saww</sup> did not order for your exit nor did I<sup>saww</sup> settle this boy (Ali<sup>asws</sup> in the Masjid), it was Allah<sup>azwj</sup>, He<sup>azwj</sup> Commanded with it'.

So Sa'd went out and Umar returned, and Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup> said: 'I<sup>saww</sup> shall be giving the flag to a man who loves Allah<sup>azwj</sup> and His<sup>azwj</sup> Rasool<sup>saww</sup>, among a lot of (other praises), (I the narrator am fearing I might err in some of it). So he<sup>saww</sup> called for Ali<sup>asws</sup> and he<sup>asws</sup> had sore eyes. So they came with him<sup>asws</sup> being driven. Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup> said: 'Open your<sup>asws</sup> eyes!' He<sup>asws</sup> said: 'I<sup>asws</sup> am not able to'. So Rasool-Allah<sup>saww</sup> applied the spittle in them, then kneaded with his<sup>saww</sup> thumb, and gave him<sup>asws</sup> the flag.

So the Qureysh begrudged upon it and they said, 'But rather he<sup>saww</sup> left him<sup>asws</sup> due to what would weigh him<sup>saww</sup> down and dislike of his<sup>asws</sup> company'. So Ali<sup>asws</sup> came over until he<sup>asws</sup> grabbed the rein of the she-camel and he<sup>asws</sup> said: 'O Prophet<sup>saww</sup> of Allah<sup>azwi</sup>! I<sup>asws</sup> shall follow you<sup>saww</sup> as I<sup>asws</sup> have always followed you<sup>asws</sup> (before). The Qureysh are alleging that you<sup>saww</sup> rather left me<sup>asws</sup> behind due to my<sup>asws</sup> weighing you<sup>saww</sup> down and you<sup>saww</sup> are dislking my<sup>asws</sup> company'.

From Ja'far<sup>asws</sup> Bin Muhammad<sup>asws</sup>, from his<sup>asws</sup> father<sup>asws</sup> having said: 'It (news) reached Muawiya that Ali<sup>asws</sup> was mobilising the people at Al-Kufa for the travel to

him<sup>asws</sup> (for battle) to Syria, and that was after the tranquillity and the government. So that reached from Muawiya (to the people) that he (Muawiya) was using sums of monies to entice the people to go towards Ali<sup>asws</sup> for the battle, and he plotted a plot regarding that and he sent Amro Bin Hureys Al-Makhzoumy to Al-Kufa.

So the man proceeded to Amro Bin Hureys and he lodged him in a place near to him, and it was so that Amir Al-Momineen did not view the wiping upon the two socks (during Wudou as being correct), and he as used to sit in the Grand Masjid of Al-Kufa issuing verdicts to the people and judge between them until the *Salat* was Obligated. So he would take off the two socks and clean the two legs and pray *Salat* (leading) the people. So when he would want to leave to go to his saws family, he would wear his saws socks and leave.

So he agreed with the man that he would ambush Ali<sup>asws</sup>, and when he<sup>asws</sup> takes off his<sup>asws</sup> sock, he would made a snake to be in one of them' – or said, 'two snakes, from what was with him. So he did that and made the snake' – or said, 'two snakes in one of the two socks. So when Amir Al-Momineen<sup>asws</sup> intended to wear his<sup>asws</sup> sock, an eagle swooped and snatched the sock and flew with it into the air. Then it dropped it and the snake came out, and it was killed.

He (the narrator) said, 'So Amir Al-Momineen<sup>asws</sup> said to the people: 'Seize the doors of the Masjid!'. They took to the doors and they looked, and there was a man, a stranger, and he was the man who had ambushed Ali<sup>asws</sup> with what he did. And he acknowledged that Muawiya had sent him for that to Amro Bin Hureys.

He (the narrator) said, 'So Amir Al-Momineen<sup>asws</sup> said: 'Bring Amro Bin Hureys to me<sup>asws</sup> and do not do anything bad to him'. So they went and came with him, and his whole body was trembling, and they wanted to kill him. But, Amir Al-Momineen<sup>asws</sup> said: 'Leave him, for it isn't him nor Muawiya who would be killing me<sup>asws</sup> nor are they both able upon that. My<sup>asws</sup> killer would be a man from (the Clan of) Murad. A striker from the left-

handed men, sinister, hump-backed, looking by the eyes of Satan<sup>la</sup>, and Amir Al-Momineen<sup>asws</sup> went on to describe him.

He<sup>asws</sup> said: 'He would be killing me<sup>asws</sup> in the Sacred Month. But rather in the Month of Ramazan. The Ummy Prophet<sup>saww</sup> Covenanted that to me<sup>asws</sup>, and he has lost, the one who forged'.

Then he asws freed Amro and prose saying: -

Those Qureysh are wishing to kill me<sup>asws</sup>, but no, by your Lord<sup>azwj</sup>, they will neither be quenched nor would they succeed. But l<sup>asws</sup> shall remain, and l<sup>asws</sup> wouldn't be seized. Welcome, and there are no adherents in the Religion when they are treacherous. They have pledged allegiance to me<sup>asws</sup>, but they would not even be loyal between them for a day, and they would incline with the people of disbelief when they turn to disbelief. And they reduced me from war, tucked up, what neither beseemed Abu Bakr nor Umar.

So if I<sup>asws</sup> were to die, they would be joyful. My<sup>asws</sup> conscience for you all is with that pounding, there being no excusing a human for it, thirty general horses, without harmony, when prohibited from these, the passing or not. And soon there would be coming to you the epic news whitening the hairs from the mention of the news. When they meet one assembled on the turf, elevating the judges or harming the wretched with it. So, soon the Mahdi<sup>asws</sup> would be Sent for His<sup>azwj</sup> Sunnah, and he<sup>asws</sup> would publicise the Revelation and the Religion which would cleanse".<sup>29</sup>

So they (creature) were ignorant of You<sup>azwj</sup> and Your<sup>azwj</sup> Worth, and they evaluated You<sup>azwj</sup> upon other than what was Your<sup>azwj</sup> worth, and resembled You<sup>azwj</sup> with Your<sup>azwj</sup> creatures.

And they will never realise You<sup>azwj</sup> although the apparent of what is with them from Your<sup>azwj</sup> bounties, does indicate them to You<sup>azwj</sup>.

Then he<sup>asws</sup> stood, and rode his<sup>asws</sup> animal'.<sup>32</sup>
