### Ziyarat-e-Imam Hussain <sup>asws</sup>

Once Imam Jafar-e-Sadiq <sup>asws</sup> asked one of his companions, what stops you from going to Ziarat at least five times a week or even better on daily basis? He replied, O my lord, may I sacrifice my life for your cause, I live far away from Imam <sup>asws</sup>'s Haram. Imam <sup>asws</sup> replied, in that case, you should go on top of your roof (higher point in your house), *look at right-hand side then left-hand side and after that turn toward the direction of Imam Hussain <sup>asws</sup>'s shrine and recite the following while looking towards the sky 'Assalam-o-Allaika ya Aba Abdullah-hay Assalam-o-Allaika Wa Rahmatullah-hay-wa-Barakatow'*, it is equivalent to visiting grave of Imam Hussain <sup>asws</sup> and sending 'Salam' from where you are (Manla Yahzar-al-Faqih, Vol.2, Traditions 3203, for details visit [www.hubeali.com](http://www.hubeali.com)).

### Rabi' ul Awwal

The Holy Prophet <sup>saww</sup> migrated from Mecca to Medina on the first-night of Rabi-ul Awwal. It is the same night when Ameer ul Momaneen Hazrat Ali ibne Abi Talib <sup>asws</sup> saved the life of messenger of Allah <sup>azwj</sup>. Allah <sup>azwj</sup> with his Angels appreciated Hazrat Ali <sup>asws</sup> at this attribution, it is recommended to fast on the first day of Rabi ul Awwal and recite Ziyarat-Ameer-al-Momaneen Ali Ibne Abi Talib. <sup>asws</sup>

 Whenever you recite 'La Ai La Ha Illallah' and 'Mohammed ar Rasool Allah' then you must immediately say 'Ali Ameer-ul-Momaneen' - (an extract from Imam Ali <sup>asws</sup> Qabah, Eeman and Yakeen, published by Shia World Federation London, pp. 100 which cites -Bahar-ul-Anwar, vol. 27, pp. 1).

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**Hadeeth-e-Imam Jafar-e-Sadiq <sup>asws</sup>**  
 A companion narrated the following Ayat in front of Imam Jafar-e-Sadiq <sup>asws</sup>, 'Tahazo .....' meaning that Christians have deserted Allah <sup>swt</sup> in the favour of their scholars and peers, and requested the meanings of this verse. Imam <sup>a.s.</sup> replied, Christians were not asked to worship their scholars and peers, if they were asked to do so by their priests then they would have rejected them. Instead, their peers turned their Halal into Haram and converted their Haram into Halal. They followed their priests' judgements (i.e., observed taqlaed) and as a result had worshiped them unconsciously. (Usool-e-Kafi, vol. 1)

**Tariq bin Shihab asked: "Ya Amir-ul-Momineen<sup>asws</sup>, please explain the virtues of an Imam (masoom), Ameer al-Momineen<sup>asws</sup> replied:**

"O Tariq, the Imam is the '**Kalima-tul-Allah**' words of Allah<sup>azwj</sup>; '**Hujat-Allah** the proof of Allah<sup>azwj</sup>; '**Waj-Allah**' the direction to Allah<sup>azwj</sup>; '**Noor-Allah**' the light of Allah<sup>azwj</sup>; '**Hijab-Allah**' the veil of Allah<sup>azwj</sup> and '**Aiat-Allah**' the sign of Allah<sup>azwj</sup>. He<sup>asws</sup> is chosen by Allah<sup>azwj</sup> who bestows onto him whatever qualities He<sup>azwj</sup> chooses, and Makes it compulsory on all His<sup>azwj</sup> creatures to obey him-the Imam<sup>asws</sup>. Thus, he<sup>asws</sup> is Allah<sup>azwj</sup>'s appointed ruler in the heavens and on the earth. Allah<sup>azwj</sup> has taken a covenant regarding this from all His<sup>azwj</sup> servants. Whosoever, precedes the Imam<sup>asws</sup> has denied established kingdom of Allah<sup>azwj</sup>. An Imam<sup>asws</sup> can act as he finds it appropriate, however his actions only correspond to the will of Allah<sup>azwj</sup>. Inscribed on his upper limb is the (declaration): The word of Allah<sup>azwj</sup> is accomplished with truth and justice. (An extract from Hadith-e-Tariq (Nahj ul Israr Page, pp. 109).

These titles of masoom Imam<sup>asws</sup> are frequently used by non-masoom during our time, as were used by Abu Bakr<sup>1.a</sup>, Ummer<sup>1.a</sup> and Usman<sup>1.a</sup> in the past.

It is narrated from Imam AbuAbdullah <sup>asws</sup>: If one finds his livelihood is heavily curtailed, or is surrounded in severe hardship or is facing unsolvable difficulties or has special wishes for the hereafter, one should write on a white piece of paper (the supplication below) ensuring all the names (of masomeen <sup>asws</sup>) are written in one line followed by one's prayers. Place it, at sunrise, in flowing stream of water.

رب مسني الضر والخوف، فاكشف ضري، وأمن خوفاي، بحق محمد وآل محمد وأسئلك بكل نبي ووصي وصديق وشهيد، أن تصلي على محمد وآل محمد، يا أرحم الراحمين. اشفعوا لي يا ساداتي بالشأن الذي لكم عند الله، فإن لكم عند الله لثانا من الشأن، فقد مسني الضر يا ساداتي والله أرحم الراحمين، فافعل بي يا رب كذا وكذا

## Days in Islamic Months:

The following months are fixed as per traditions of masomeen <sup>asws</sup>: Muharram 30; Rajab 30; Shaban 29; Ramazan 30; Zeeqad 30; Zilhajj 29; whereas the other months will be fully complete or partially less (30 or 29 days), Faroo-e-Kafi, vol.2., in another hadith Imam Jafar-e-Sadiq <sup>asws</sup> said Allah <sup>azwj</sup> has created earth in six days, then specified year and divided it into 354 days, so Shaban would never be complete (29 days), by Allah <sup>azwj</sup>, Ramazan would never be incomplete as obligation (to Allah) cannot be imperfect, since Allah <sup>azwj</sup> Says to complete this month's duration. Shawal will be 29 days, Zeeqad 30 days, Zilhajj 29 days and Muharram 30 days, whereas the rest of the months will come as one complete (30 days) followed by one incomplete (29 days), Faroo-e-Kafi, tradition 2, vol. 3, pp. 229.

## Ramzan-ul-Mubarak

It is narrated from 8<sup>th</sup> Imam <sup>asws</sup> that the first month of the year for righteous people is the month of Ramadan (Manlayazahoor al faqi Vol-1 page-522)

**Onset of Sahr:** Imam Jafar <sup>asws</sup> says: It's when the morning brightness would break through the darkness of the night. (Faroo-e-Kafi, tradition 3, vol. 3, pp. 255).

**Onset of Iftar:** Imam Mohammed Baqir <sup>asws</sup> said when Sky redness disappears completely from the East and passes over your head towards the West, then it becomes obligatory to break fast. (Faroo-e-Kafi, tradition 2, vol. 3, pp. 259, & Page-279).

## Shawwal

The 1<sup>st</sup> of Shawwal is the Eid ul Fitr . Abdul ibn Denar has narrated from Imam Zain-ul-Abadeen <sup>asws</sup> that Imam <sup>asws</sup> said: Oh! Abdullah, either it is Eid-ul-Zaha or Eid-ul-Fitr of Muslims, it should refresh the grief and sufferings of Ahlul bait <sup>asws</sup> (Abdullah asked), how it is mola? Imam <sup>asws</sup> replied because it makes one realise that our Divine rights have been usurped by our enemies (*Sahifa-e-Sajjadia*). On the Eid day it is also mustahab to take bath and recite Ziyarat-e-Imam Hussain <sup>asws</sup> It is obligatory on everyone, including the rich and the poor as well as the resourceful and the slave which is equivalent to one 'Salah' (2.8 kg) of dates or wheat or dried grapes, or whatever one usually eats during the year (i.e., £5, please reconfirm this amount, see, for example [www.hubeali.com](http://www.hubeali.com)).

It is narrated from Imam AlRaza <sup>asws</sup> by Mohammed bin alfazil that some followers of Imam <sup>asws</sup> came to see Him <sup>asws</sup> on the day of Eid-UI-Fitar, Imam <sup>asws</sup> greeted them:- O so-and-so Allah <sup>asws</sup> accepted from you and from Us <sup>asws</sup>. And when they came again to see Imam <sup>asws</sup> on the Day of Sacrifice Imam <sup>asws</sup> greeted them:- O so-and-so accepted Allah <sup>azwj</sup> from ourselves <sup>asws</sup> and from yourself. I asked Imam <sup>asws</sup>: O Ibn Rasoul Allah <sup>saww</sup> on the day of Eid-UI-Fitar You <sup>asws</sup> greeted us differently as when we visited you on the Day of Sacrifice. Imam <sup>asws</sup> replied, yes, I <sup>asws</sup> said for the Eid-UI-Fitar that Allah <sup>azwj</sup> accepted from you and from Us <sup>asws</sup> because yourself and ourselves <sup>asws</sup> did the same thing (fasting), And I <sup>asws</sup> said for on the Day of Sacrifice : Allah <sup>azwj</sup> accepted from ourselves <sup>asws</sup> and from yourself. This is due to the fact that we <sup>asws</sup> are able to do the sacrifice and you are unable of offering the sacrifice. (Ref. Bihar-ul-Anwar, vol. 5, pp. 172).

If one cannot go to perform Hajj nor could go to Karbala than one should go away from the city and recite Ziyarat-e-Imam Hussain <sup>asws</sup> and spend whole day in praying and supplications.

The 18<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> are very important Eid days-the Eid-e-Ghadeer and Eid-e-Mubahila.

## Muharram-ul-Harram

Imam Aba Abdullah<sup>asws</sup> was asked about keeping fast on the 9th and 10th of Muharram. Imam<sup>asws</sup> replied, Syrian army, on the planes of Karbala, rejoiced on the 9<sup>th</sup>, after forming and moving forward to surround Imam Huassin<sup>asws</sup> and his<sup>asws</sup> companions. Ibn Ziad<sup>la</sup> reinforced his army and proudly looked at the endless rows of his soldiers which had outnumbered few companions of Imam Hussain<sup>asws</sup>, he was convinced no one will come forward to join Imam Hussain<sup>asws</sup>'s camp and people of Iraq will consider him<sup>asws</sup> weak and will not dare to protect Imam<sup>asws</sup> against his huge build-up. Ashora (10th) was that day when Imam Hussain<sup>asws</sup> along with companions were lying on the sand of Karbala, with heads removed from their bodies. Is it appropriate to fast on that day? Surely, not. By the Lord<sup>azwj</sup> of Kabah! It is not a fasting day, it's the day of sadness and moaning. All momaneen, on the earth and in the heavens should be grieving on this day. This was a day of joy for the people of Syria, decedents of Marjana<sup>la</sup> and Ibn Ziad<sup>la</sup>. Allah<sup>azwj</sup> admonished them on this day; this is the day when all parts of the world cried except the Syrian segment. Whoever would fast on this day for the purpose of seeking blessings, Allah<sup>azwj</sup> will resurrect him with 'dead' heart and punish him severely in the hereafter. Whoever would indulge in acquiring and piling worldly goods for him and/or for his family/relatives, Allah<sup>azwj</sup> will take back His<sup>azwj</sup> blessings and implant disbelief in his heart, to remain there, until the final day. And Iblis<sup>la</sup> will have share in their deeds and activities. (Faroo-e-Kafi, tradition 7, vol. 3, pp. 321)

### Visiting Holy Shrines/Ziarat

It is recommended by Imam-e-Jafar-e-Sadiq<sup>asws</sup> to fast for three days before leaving your house for Ziarat-e-Imam Hussain<sup>asws</sup> and perform 'Ghusal' on the third day. Then gather your family and pray to Allah<sup>azwj</sup>, 'O Lord! ... (please read the rest from www.hubeali.com). Do not take with you 'delicious foods' (e.g., roasted meat, halva) and eat very basic diet upon arriving there. In another tradition, quoted by Sheikh Sadduq, someone asked what should we eat there? Imam Jafar-e-Sadiq<sup>asws</sup> replied, 'Eat bread with Milk' (Sawab-ul-Amal and Aqab-ul-Amal, pp. 98, hadith 22).
