Never ever abandon our Ziarat for any kind of fear/threat. Whoever would shy away from performing our Ziarat will regret on the final day of judgement and proclaim, alas! I would have stayed near the grave of Imam Hussain^{asws} until my very last breath. Don’t you wish to be among those who are in the prayers of Rasool Allah^{saww}, Mola Ali^{asws}, Syeda Fatima^{asws} and Masoom Imams^{asws}? Don’t you like to be among those who would be welcomed and greeted by the angles on the Doomsday? Don’t you want to be among those who would have no sins in their accounts on the final Day of Judgement? It is narrated from Imam Hassan Askari^{asws} that it is Mustahab to recite Ziyarat e Ashura on the chehlum of Shuhda e Karbala.

Ziarat-e-Imam Hussain^{asws}

Ziarat Imam Hussain^{asws} is wajib everyday, once Imam Jafar-e-Sadiq^{asws} asked from one of his companions, what stops you from going to Ziarat at least five times a week or even better on daily basis? He replied, O my lord, may I sacrifice my life for your cause, I live far away from Imam^{asws}'s Harram. Imam^{asws} replied, in that case, you should go on top of your roof (higher point in your house), look at right-hand side then left-hand side and after that turn toward the direction of Imam Hussain^{asws}'s shrine and say the following while looking into sky 'Assalam-o-Allaika ya Aba Abdullah-hay Assalam-o-Allaika Wa Rahmatullah-hay-wa-Barakatow', it is equivalent to visiting grave of Imam Hussain^{asws} and sending 'Salam' from where you are (Manla Yahzar-al-Faqih, Vol.2, Tradition 3203, for details visit www.hubeali.com).

Rabi' ul Awwal

The Holy Prophet^{saww} migrated from Mecca to Medina on the first-night of Rabi-ul Awwal. It is the same night when Ameer ul Momaneen Hazrat Ali ibne Abi Talib^{asws} saved the life of Messenger of Allah^{azwj}. Allah^{azwj} with his Angels appreciated Hazrat Ali^{asws} at this contribution. It is recommended to fast on the first day of Rabi ul Awwal and recite Ziyarat-Ameer-al-Momaneen Ali Ibne Abi Talib.^{asws}

Hadeeth-e-Imam Jafar-e-Sadiq^{asws}

If someone takes up religion (of Mohammed^{asws} and Alay Mohammed^{asws}) from another person (Taqlaed) then his religion remains infirm and is easily destroyed by others (preachers) but if he takes it from 'Quran and Sunnah', then mountains may tremble but not his faith. (Mustadrak ul wasail, vol. 17, pp. 308)

Hadeeth-e-Imam Jafar-e-Sadiq^{asws}

So came the order from the Imam Ja'far Al Sadiq^{asws}: 'Whoever says – There is no God but Allah, Muhammad is the messenger of Allah must immediately say Ali is the Commander of the Faithful'. - (an extract from Imam Ali^{asws}. Qabah, Eeman and Yakeen, published by Shia World Federation London, pp. 100 which cites -Bahar-ul-Anwar, vol. 27, pp. 1).

Hadeeth-e-Imam Jafar-e-Sadiq^{asws}

A companion narrated the following Ayat in front of Imam Jafar-e-Sadiq^{asws}, 'Tahazo(9:31).' meaning that Christians have deserted Allah^{swt}. in the favour of their scholars and peers, and requested the meanings of this verse. Imam^{asws} replied, Christians were not asked to worship their scholars and peers, if they were asked to do so by their priests then they would have rejected them. Instead, their peers turned their Halal into Haram and converted their Haram into Halal. They followed their priests' judgements (i.e., observed taqlaed) and as a result had worshiped them unconsciously. (Usool-e-Kafi, vol. 1)

On the 20th of this month is Zahoor-e-Basaadat Janab-e-Syeda-e-Konaen Bibi Fatima Zahra^{asws}, it is mustahab to fast on this day and one should thank Allah^{azwj} for Zahoor of Syeda^{asws} Momanen/nat may recite Namaz-e-Syeda^{asws} and Ziyarat-e-Syeda^{asws}.
 Mohammed bin alFazeel alDuruki narrates from Abu Hamza alSumali, who says I heard it from Imam Ali bin Al Hussain^{asws} that Fatima Bint Asad^{asws} was performing circumambulation of Kaaba when its wall (suddenly) opened (with noise) and Bibi entered into Kaaba and there came (to this world) Amir-ul-Momaneen^{asws}. (Rawzatul Waizeen Vol-1,Page-82 and also in Bihar Vol-35,Page-23)

Tariq bin Shihab asked: "Ya Ameer al-Momineen^{asws}, please explain the virtues of an Imam (masoom), Ameer al-Momineen^{asws} replied:

"O Tariq, the Imam is the 'Kalima-tul-Allah' words of Allah; 'Hujat-Allah' the proof of Allah; 'Waj-Allah' the direction to Allah; 'Noor-Allah' the light of Allah; 'Hijab-Allah' the veil of Allah and 'Ayat-Allah' the sign of Allah^{azwj}. He^{asws} is chosen by Allah^{azwj} who bestows onto him whatever qualities He^{azwj} chooses, and Makes it compulsory on all His creatures to obey him-the Imam. Thus, he is Allah^{azwj}'s appointed ruler in the heavens and on the earth. Allah^{azwj} has taken a covenant regarding this from all His servants. Whosoever, precedes the Imam^{asws} denies the established kingdom of Allah^{azwj}. An Imam can act as he finds it appropriate, however his actions only correspond to the Will of Allah^{azwj}. Inscribed on his upper limb is the (declaration): The word of Allah^{azwj} is accomplished with truth and justice. (An extract from Hadith-e-Tariq (Nahj ul Israr Page, pp. 109).

These titles of Masoom Imam^{asws} are frequently used by non-masoom during our time, as were used by Abu Bakr^{la}, Ummer^{la} and Usman^{la} in the past.

It is narrated from Imam AbuAbdullah^{asws}: If one finds his livelihood is heavily curtailed, or is surrounded in severe hardship or is facing unsolvable difficulties or has special wishes for the hereafter, one should write on a white piece of paper (the supplication below) ensuring all the names (of Masomeen^{asws}) are written in one line followed by one's prayers. Place it, at sunrise, in a flowing stream of water (canal/river).

and You^{azwj} are my Grand Lord. I send (through You^{azwj}) 'Salam' (peace) to: Mohammad, Ali, and Fatima, Al-Hassan, Al-Hussain and Ali and Mohamed, Jafar, and Musa and Ali, Mohammad and Ali and Al Hassan and Al Qaem, Who are our chiefs and masters, who are all Allah^{azwj}'s praise worthy and chosen ones. My Lord^{azwj}, please relieve me from fear, and help me from losses and damages, from what I see and from what I do not perceive. For the sake of Mohammad^{asws} and Alay Mohammad^{asws}'s Rights, for the sake of each Prophet^{as}, their successors' behalf including the Truthfuls and the Shaheeds. I pray to You^{azwj} with reference to Mohammad^{asws} and the Muhammad's Family^{asws}, O! The Most Merciful, I ask for Your^{azwj} intercession, The Most Elevated and the most Praised Lord, I have been disgraced by some severe circumstances, difficulties have immensely affected me, O my Lord^{azwj}, my Allah^{azwj}, the Most Merciful, please award me O Allah^{azwj} such and such....(write your prayers), (Ref. The following months are fixed as per traditions of Masomeen^{asws}: Muharram 30; Rajab 30; Shaban 29; Ramazan 30; Zeeqad 30; Zilhajj 29; whereas the other months will be fully complete or partially less (30 or 29 days), Faroo-e-Kafi, vol.2., in another hadith Imam Jafar-e-Sadiq^{asws} said Allah^{azwj} has created earth in six days, then specified year and divided it into 354 days, so Shaban would never be complete (29 days), by Allah^{azwj}, month of Ramazan would never be incomplete as obligation (to Allah) cannot be imperfect, since Allah^{azwj} Says to complete this month's duration. 'Shawwal

The 1st of Shawwal is the Eid ul Fitr . Abdul ibn Denar has narrated from Imam Zain-ul-Abedeem^{asws} that Imam^{asws} said: 'Oh! Abdullah, either it is Eid-ul-Zaha or Eid-ul-Fitr of Muslims, it refreshes the grief and sufferings of Ahlul bait^{asws} (Abdullah asked), how it is mola^{asws}? Imam^{asws} replied because it makes one realise that our Divine rights have been usurped by our enemies' (*Sahifa-e-Sajjadia*). On the Eid day it is also mustahab to take bath and recite Ziyarat-e-Imam Hussain^{asws} It is obligatory on everyone, including the rich and the poor as well as the resourceful and the slave to give Fitra which is equivalent to one 'Sa'ah' (2.8 kg) of dates or wheat or dried grapes, or whatever one usually eats during the year (i.e., £5, please reconfirm this amount, see, for example www.hubeali.com).

It is narrated from Imam AlRaza^{asws} by Mohammed bin alfazil that some followers of Imam^{asws} came to see Him^{asws} on the day of Eid-UI-Fitar, Imam^{asws} greeted them:- 'O so-and-so Allah^{asws} accepted from you and from Us^{asws}. And when they came again to see Imam^{asws} on the Day of Sacrifice Imam^{asws} greeted them:- O so-and-so accepted Allah^{azwj} from ourselves^{asws} and from yourself'. I asked Imam^{asws}: 'O Ibn Rasoul Allah^{saww} on the day of Eid-UI-Fitar You^{asws} greeted us differently as when we visited you on the Day of Sacrifice'. Imam^{asws} replied, 'yes', I^{asws} said for the Eid-UI-Fitar that Allah^{azwj} accepted from you and from Us^{asws} because yourself and ourselves^{asws} did the same thing (fasting), And I^{asws} said: 'For on the Day of Sacrifice : Allah^{azwj} accepted from ourselves^{asws} and from yourself. This is due to the fact that we^{asws} are able to do the sacrifice and you are unable of offering the sacrifice'. (Ref. Bihar-ul-Anwar, vol. 5, pp. 172).

The 25th of this month is the day when the earth was laid down under the Holy Ka'ba It is also the day when Holy Ka'ba was built and it is the day when Hazrat Adam^{as} was asked to pay respect to the Ka'ba. Hazrat Imam Ali^{asws} says, when a momin prays at this night and fasts on the day, it is equivalent to the 'Ibadat' (Worship) of one hundred years.

30th of this month is martyrdom of Imam Taqi^{asws} therefore it is obligatory to hold ritual mourning gathering (Majlis O Matam).

The 18th and 24th are very important Eid days-the Eid-e-Ghadeer and Eid-e-Mubahila.

Muharram-ul-Harram

Imam Aba Abdullah^{asws} was asked about keeping fast on the 9th and 10th of Muharram. Imam^{asws} replied, Syrian army, on the planes of Karbala, rejoiced on the 9th, after forming and moving forward to surround Imam Hussain^{asws} and his^{asws} companions. Ibn Ziad^{la} reinforced his army and proudly looked at the endless rows of his soldiers which had outnumbered few companions of Imam Hussain^{asws}, he was convinced no one will come forward to join Imam Hussain^{asws}'s camp and people of Iraq will consider him^{asws} weak and will not dare to protect Imam^{asws} against his huge build-up. Ashora (10th) was that day when Imam Hussain^{asws} along with companions were lying on the sand of Karbala, with heads removed from their bodies. Is it appropriate to fast on that day? Surely, not. By the Lord^{azwj} of Kabah! It is not a fasting day, it's the day of sadness and moaning. All momaneen, on the earth and in the heavens should be grieving on this day. This was a day of joy for the people of Syria, decedents of Marjana^{la} and Ibn Ziad^{la}. Allah^{azwj} admonished them on this day; this is the day when all parts of the world cried except the Syrian segment. Whoever would fast on this day for the purpose of seeking blessings, Allah^{azwj} will resurrect him with 'dead' heart and punish him severely in the hereafter. Whoever would indulge in acquiring and piling worldly goods for him and/or for his family/relatives, Allah^{azwj} will take back His^{azwj} blessings and implant disbelief in his heart, to remain there, until the final day. And Iblis^{la} will have share in their deeds and activities. (Faroo-e-Kafi, tradition 7, vol. 3, pp. 321)

Visiting Holy Shrines/Ziarat

It is recommended by Imam-e-Jafar-e-Sadiq^{asws} to fast for three days before leaving your house for Ziarat-e-Imam Hussain^{asws} and perform 'Ghusal' on the third day. Then gather your family and pray to Allah^{azwj}, 'O Lord! ... (please read the rest from www.hubeali.com). Do not take with you 'delicious foods' (e.g., roasted meat, halva) and eat very basic diet upon arriving there. In another tradition, quoted by Sheikh Sadduq, someone asked what should we eat there? Imam Jafar-e-Sadiq^{asws} replied, 'Eat bread with Milk' (Sawab-ul-Amal and Aqab-ul-Amal, pp. 98..hadith 22).
